Because these cards will be note cards or birthday cards, and not holiday cards, the art can be abstract, realistic, or any style that is the child's preference. It's up to your child's imagination. The cards can be completed at home, in school or at the NDVS/School for the Blind. Feel free to submit more than one picture. The artwork can be something your child made in the past. It doesn't have to be something they recently created, but they can't submit things that were submitted for a different year. The art is best on 8 ½ X 11 inch paper, but can be much smaller. The largest it can be is on 11X17 paper. Remember that the artwork can also be a sculpture, or a photograph taken by your child.
